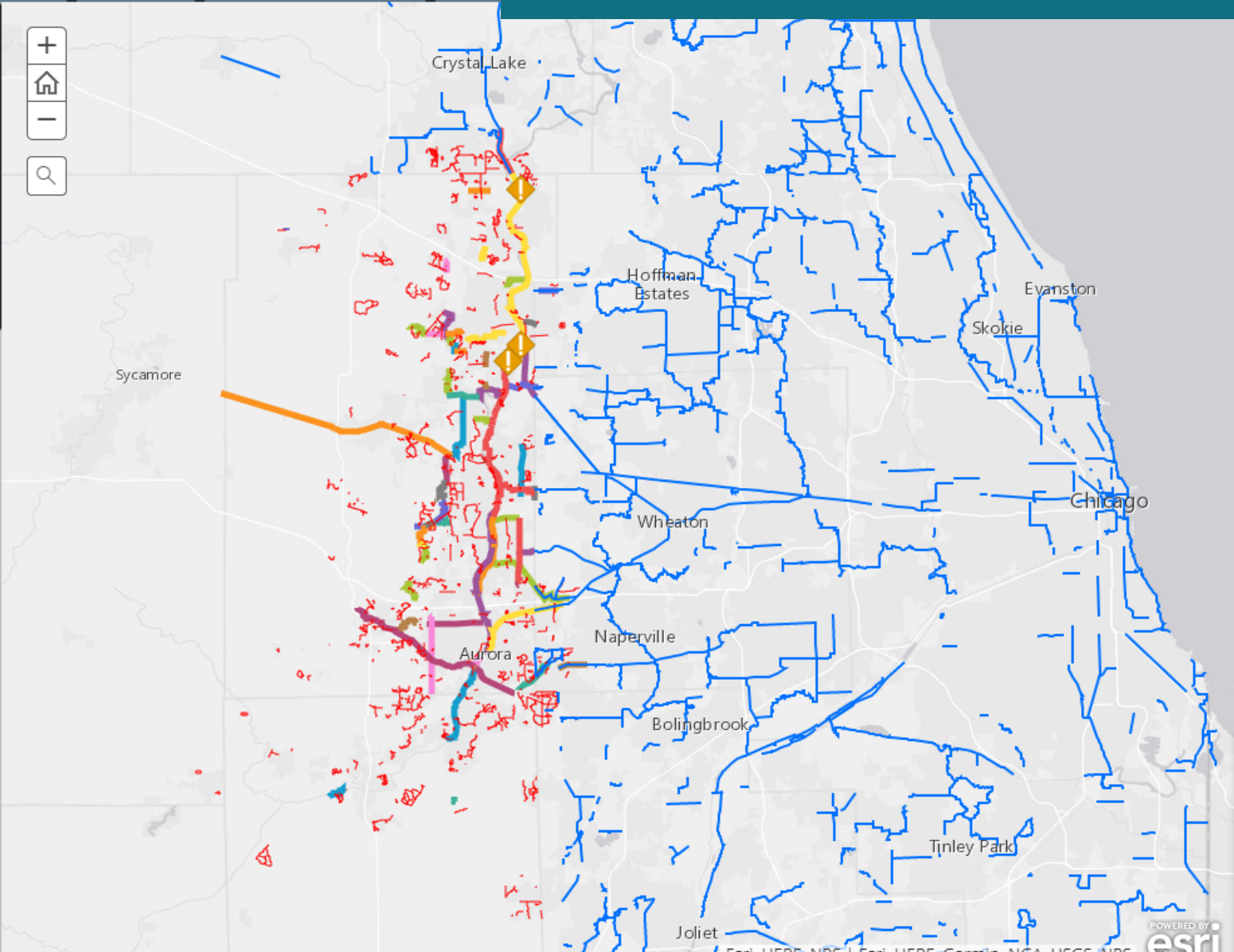

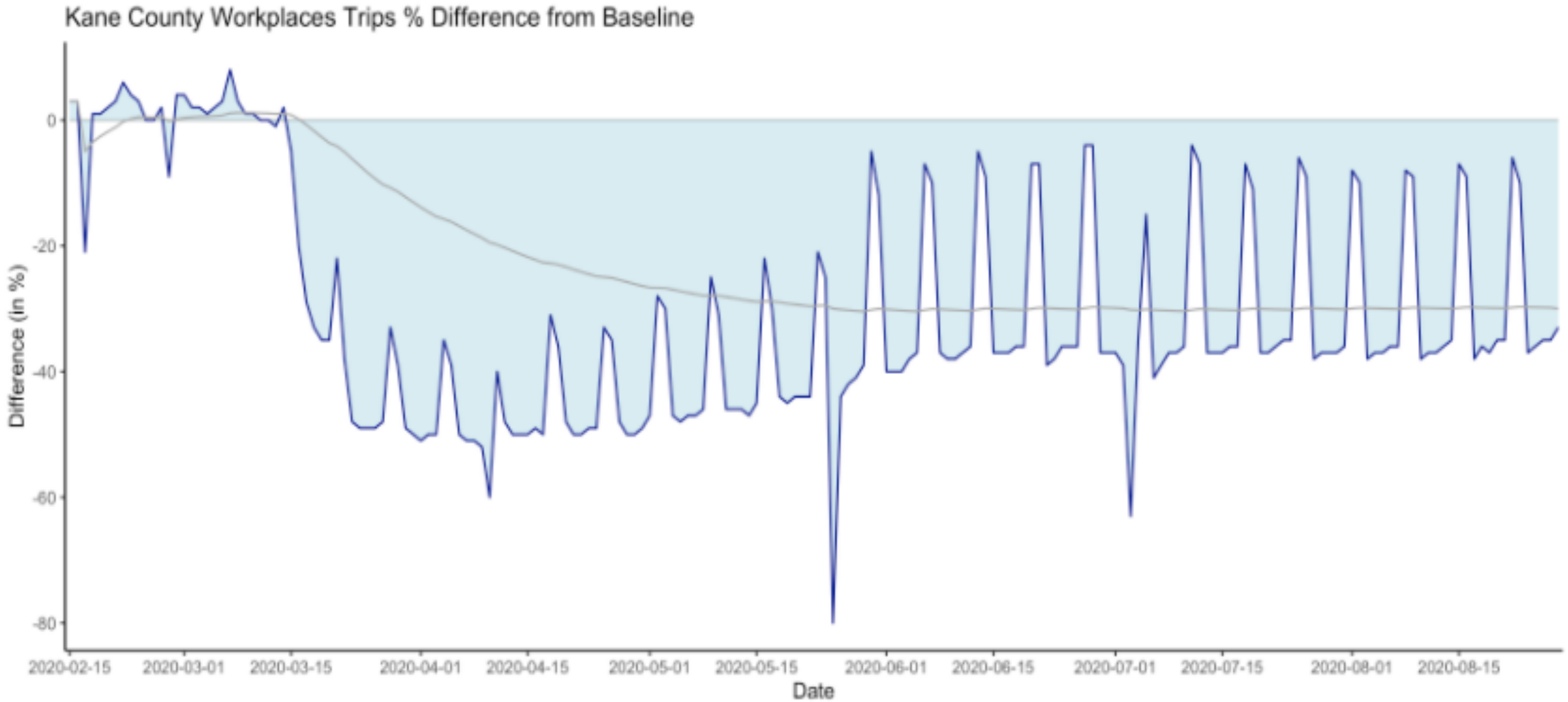

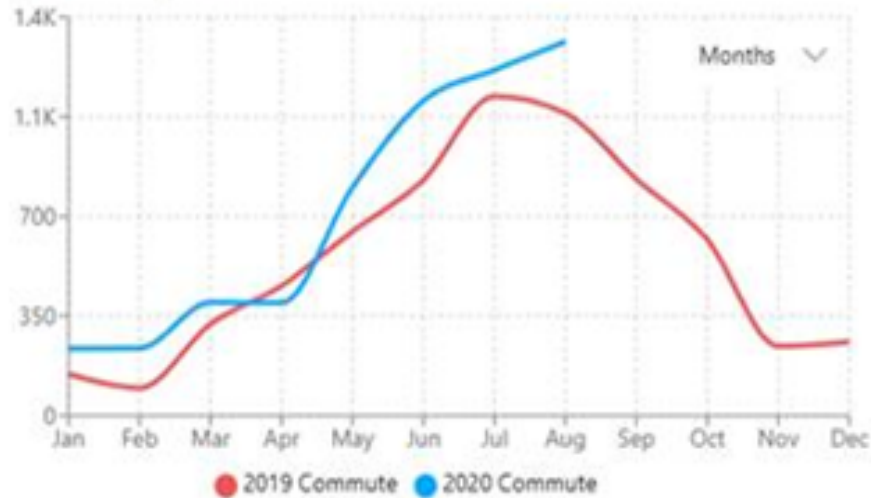

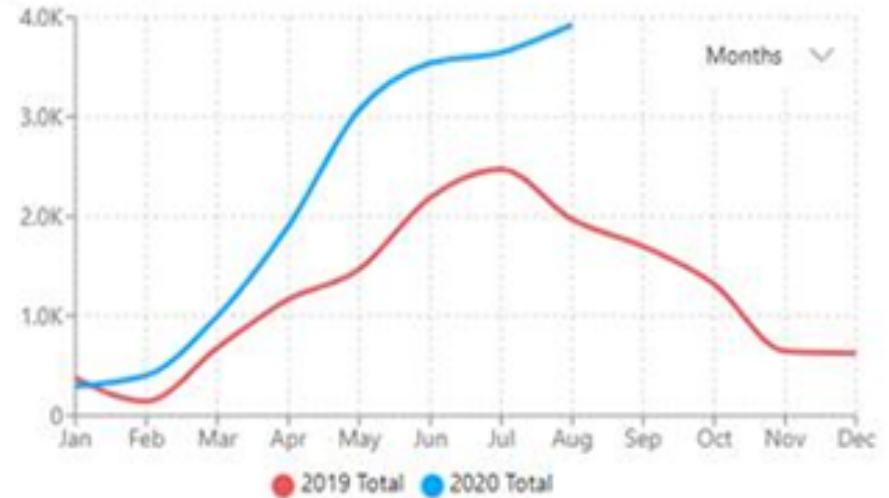

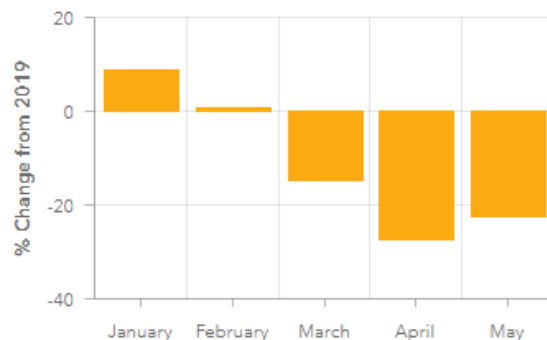

2020 sales tax revenue compared to 2019

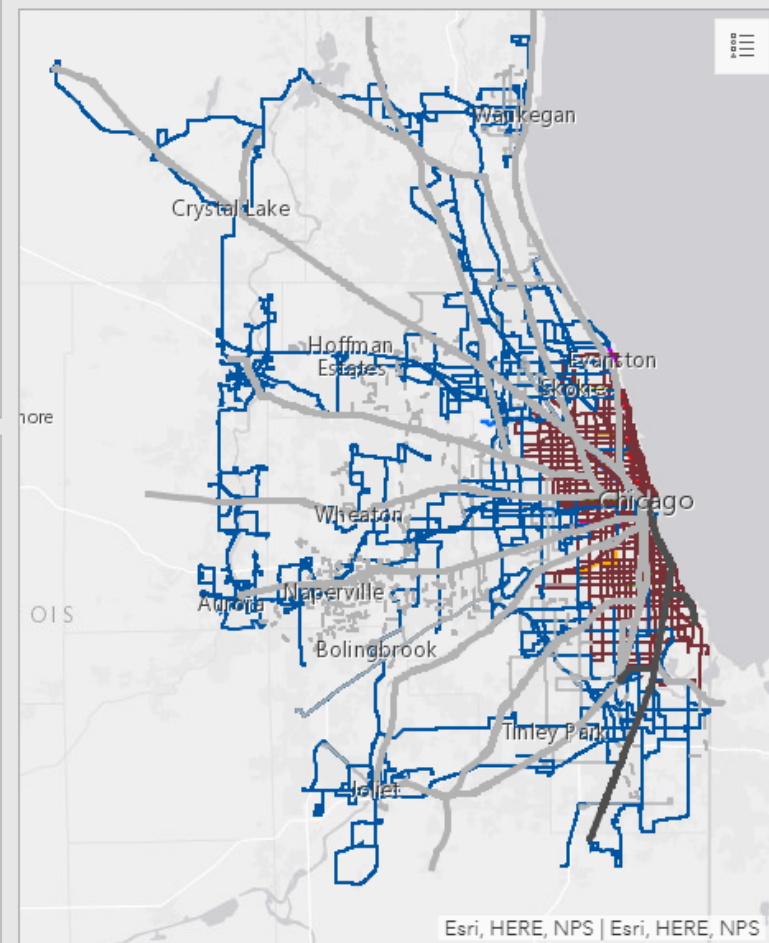

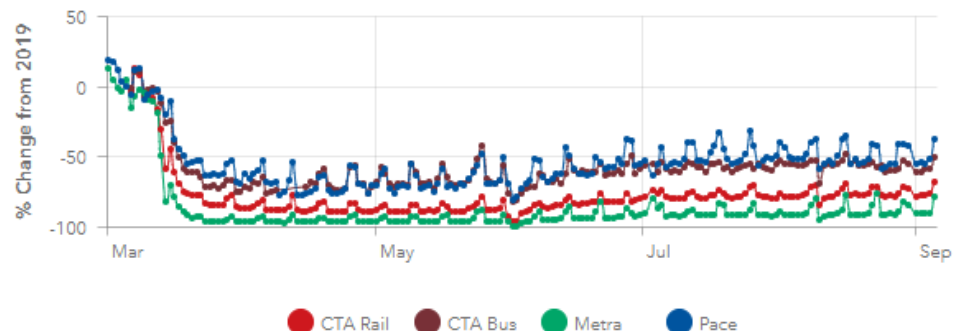


Current Reduced Transit Service

2020 ridership compared to 2019

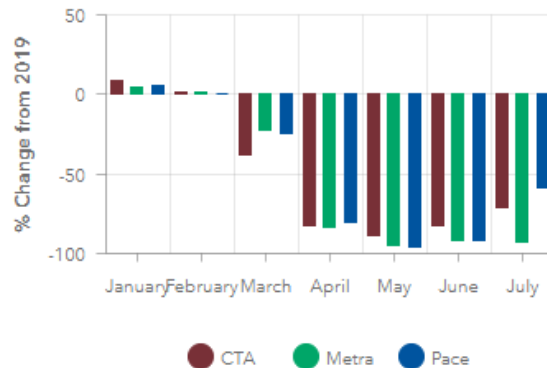

2020 farebox revenue compared to 2019

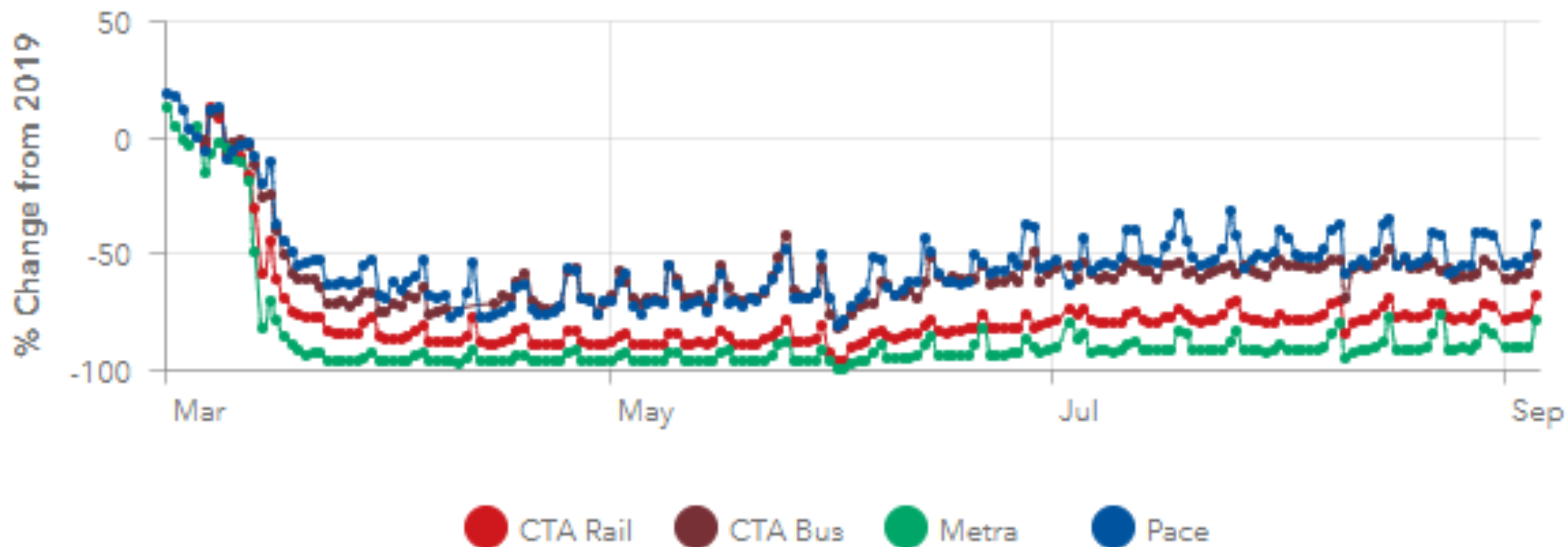
