




Fox Valley Sustainability Network

Kane County 2040 Plan

- In May 2012, the Board adopted the Kane County 2040 Plan which incorporated the following Sustainability and Energy policies:
 - 2.9.5—Promote small and utility scale renewable energy generation.
 - 2.9.7—Enhance opportunities for innovation, economic development and a workforce trained in the energy efficiency and renewable energy industries.
 - 2.9.8—Educate the community about the vulnerabilities that may result from changes in climate and available mitigation and adaptation strategies.

Solsmart Designation



- Bronze SolSmart Designation 2017 https://solsmart.org/
 - ► Helping communities streamline solar process and remove barriers
- SolSmart Criteria:
 - Created an online permitting checklist, increasing transparency for community members and solar installers
 - Reviewed local zoning codes and identified restrictions that intentionally or unintentionally prohibit solar PV development
- Program highlights:
 - Engaged and educated local residents and businesses on solar energy
 - In partnership with Fox Valley Sustainability Network, the County hosted multiple solar-focused educational events and leads a regional solar task force that continues to pursue opportunities for expediting local solar development

How to go Solar

- Permitting and Planning, Zoning and Development Regulations
 - To obtain a permit for a solar installation in unincorporated Kane County, applicants will need to submit the standard **Building & Zoning Permit Application** along with two attachments:
 - ► 1. Solar Power Handout Information Required for Permit Application
 - 2. Required Submittals for Solar Panel Systems
